The materials were provided to persons with disabilities participating in Basic and Advanced Tailoring Skills Training conducted at the VOICE Center.</p> <p>The program was generously supported by STG of ARM Rtn. Udayaram Shrestha, whose valuable contribution helped strengthen skill-based livelihood opportunities for trainees with disabilities. Approximately 12,000 meters of fabric and tailoring materials were distributed and utilized during the training sessions.</p> <p>Using the provided materials, trainees successfully produced a variety of practical and marketable products including bags, T-mats, and other handmade tailoring items. The initiative aimed to enhance vocational skills, promote self-employment opportunities, and encourage economic independence among persons with disabilities.</p> <p>The training material support has significantly contributed to improving practical learning experiences and boosting the confidence of trainees to engage in income-generating activities.
