As part of this initiative, 25 trainees with disabilities are currently engaged in basic and advanced tailoring training aimed at enhancing economic inclusion and creating employment opportunities.</p> <p>The club's Sergeant-at-Arms, Rtn. Udayaram Shrestha, contributed generously by donating over 600 meters of fabric. This in-kind support will be used during hands-on tailoring sessions, helping trainees refine their practical skills and build confidence in their craft.</p> <p>This contribution reflects the club's strong commitment to empowering marginalized communities through vocational training and inclusive development.
