This service initiative marks the first community service project of the Rotary Year 2025–26.</p> <p>This program aimed to promote mobility and independence among persons with disabilities—specifically, individuals with spinal cord injuries and polio-related physical impairments—who are currently receiving 4.5 months of Basic and Advanced Tailoring Training at the VOICE Center run by SISN.
